What Makes St. Benedict's Unique (5th-8th)?

The Middle School years represent a time of change, transition, and immense growth. At St. Benedict's, we provide a supportive and stimulating middle school environment for students. Our faculty respect adolescents' emerging identities and changing interests, working as a team to support students as they navigate new experiences. We provide a strong academic environment that prepares students for life and leadership while equipping them with the skills needed to think independently and creatively. We encourage our students—from fifth graders being introduced to Middle School to eighth graders anticipating the rigors of high school—to take risks and learn who they are.

Academic Programs:

Our Middle School offers a dynamic curriculum designed to challenge and inspire students.

Engaging Learning:

Our rotating class schedule includes eight periods, providing active engagement through various learning methods: Socratic seminars, labs, class discussions, and game-based learning, ensuring an interactive experience.

Core and Co-Curricular Classes:

Students take five core classes—English, Math, History, Science, and Spanish. Co-curricular options include Integrated Arts, Band, PE, Religion, SWARM, and multiple clubs.

Spanish Language:

Spanish is a core subject taught by native speakers. In preschool and lower school, students develop a love of the language through songs, stories, and projects. In middle school, students deepen their understanding of the language through reading, writing, and conversation. Earning a high school credit in 8th grade, students enter high school as a second or third year Spanish student.

STEAM:

St. Benedict's Episcopal School has been awarded the Cognia STEM Certification, reflecting our commitment to exceptional STEM education. By integrating Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics into our curriculum, we foster collaboration, creativity, critical thinking, and problem solving while preparing students for a growing STEAM job market. St. Benedict's also offers STEAM diplomas for all graduates.









Extracurricular Activities:

St. Benedict's offers a rich variety of extracurricular opportunities to promote exploration and leadership. Check out our website for additional information regarding athletics.

Clubs and Fine Arts:
