As an Episcopal school, we value openness and inclusion and believe spiritual growth is an essential part of a well-rounded education. St. Benedict's welcomes families of all faiths. We're committed to exposing our students to other religious traditions while helping them deepen their own spiritual practices.

Preschool Curriculum

St. Benedict's welcomes the youngest of our students into an environment rich in play and imagination which sets the stage for further educational development. Our teachers have created a curriculum that provides opportunities for growth in the following developmental domains: Cognitive, Physical, Social-Emotional, Play, Learning, Communication, Language, and Literacy. Spanish is a core part of the curriculum. Preschool 3s and PreK have focused lessons with one of our Spanish teachers multiple days a week. The 3s and PreK also rotate through specials that include music class, PE, and library visits. Beginning in preschool 1s, we introduce phonetic awareness through the use of Zoo-phonics, and beginning in Preschool 3s, we introduce letter formation through Handwriting Without Tears. Outdoor play is an intrinsic part of our day. Our teachers structure the environment but not the processes of play itself. We allow flexibility in our daily plans to meet the interests of the children. We strive to create a framework of love and acceptance that will set the stage for discovery and growth and build a firm foundation for later learning.
