CHANGES TO PRESCHOOL CLUBS FOR SPRING 2025

Due to limited classroom space, for the first time St. B's will offer Preschool 3s - Pre-K Clubs at two different times in an effort to continue to offer a variety of Club options for our students. Important things to note about this change:

- Each student may only attend one Club per day.
- On Club days, students who register for 2:20–3:20 pm Clubs MUST be registered for aftercare between Preschool dismissal at 12:45 and the start of clubs at 2:20. Students may not be picked up at 12:45 and returned to campus for a Club.
- Preschool 3s students who enroll in Clubs cannot be in an aftercare nap room (even on non-club days).

SPRING 2025 Club Policies & Procedures

PICK-UP (if your child does not stay for aftercare after Club)

PRESCHOOL CLUBS: 1:10 - 2:10 pm OR 2:20 - 3:20 pm

Park in the reserved parking spaces by the Stingers Squad door and use PikMyKid to announce your arrival. Your child will be brought to meet you at the Courtyard Door.

KINDERGARTEN CLUBS: 2:20 - 3:20 pm

Park in the reserved parking spaces by the Stingers Squad door and use PikMyKid to announce your arrival. Your child will be brought to meet you at the Courtyard Door.

1st – 4th GRADE CLUBS: 3:30 – 4:30 pm (4:30 carpool, Main Campus)

Please display your carpool number on your rear-view mirror and follow the usual carpool route around the back of the building (Main Campus). Use PikMyKid to announce your arrival.

5th – 8th GRADE CLUBS: 3:30 – 4:30 pm (4:30 carpool, South Campus)

Please display your carpool number on your rear-view mirror and follow the usual carpool route around the back of the middle school building (South Campus) up to the front door. Use PikMyKid to announce your arrival. Your child will come out of the front door.

PAYMENTS AND FEES

- Clubs may be paid in full at the time of registration or you may select a payment plan.
- Registration closes on December 12, 2024. A \$25 late registration fee will be charged for any registrations after the closing date (which will be available in very limited circumstances).
- Any registered student that remains after their Club ends will be given a 5-minute grace period after the official Club end time (or, after 4:30 Club carpool ends if your student is in 1st-4th grade). After this 5-minute grace period, you will be billed at the emergency drop-in rate of \$16 per hour.
- Extended care closes promptly at 6:00 pm. Any registered student that is not picked up by 6:00 pm will be charged \$1.00 per minute for late pickup after 6:00 pm.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

- Registration will close on December 12, 2024. You may cancel before registration closes for a full refund.
- There are no refunds or changes, including moving to other Clubs, once Clubs registration closes.
- Club enrollment is assessed in early December. If a Club has not met its minimum enrollment, it will be
 canceled, and you will be contacted and asked to select another Club. If you choose to move to a
 different Club that has met its minimum enrollment, the difference in the cost of the club will be
 adjusted in your account. If there is not another Club you wish to move your child to, your money will be
 fully refunded. The decision to move to a new Club or request a refund must be made within 24 hours
 of the notification from Stingers Squad to allow time to prepare for the start of Clubs.
- Contact the Stingers Squad staff at <u>clubs@stbs.org</u> to request changes PRIOR to the close of registration on December 12, 2024.
- If the school should cancel a Club for any reason, a 100% refund (or a pro-rated refund if Clubs have begun) will be given.
- In cases of inclement weather or other school cancelations which result in cancelling a Club, the Club
 must be made up during the make-up day at the end of the semester or at another time as approved
 by the Head of Auxiliary Programming. The Head of Auxiliary Programming reserves the right to waive
 making up a Club should enough school closings make it difficult to work in all the necessary make-up
 Clubs. In this instance, refunds may be issued to parents and payment deducted from vendors for the
 missed Club, at the discretion of the Head of Auxiliary Programming.
- Club providers are allowed to miss one Club session per semester without a required make-up day (although most do schedule a make-up if a session is missed).
